

Ms. Cristiana Flutur is an Economics graduate from the Faculty of Finance and Banking, Bucharest Academy of Economic Studies and holds a master's degree from the same university in European Economics. She has an extensive experience in the public sector, in both national and international institutions.

Cristiana joined the National Authority for Management and Regulation in Communications (ANCOM) in 2012, as an expert in International Relations and European Affairs. She has an active role in representing Romania in the ITU and other international and European forums ever since.

In June 2019, she was appointed Director for International Affairs in ANCOM, managing the activity of three units which cover international and EU affairs, the organization of events and travels.

Ms. Flutur is the first woman to have held the position of chair of the Committee for ITU Policy (Com-ITU) and co-president of CEPT (The European Conference of Postal and Telecommunications Administrations), for two consecutive mandates from June 2018 to June 2024. From this position, she acted as main coordinator for the European Common Proposals and Positions in the ITU.

Cristiana is also chair of the Advisory Board for the Network of women for ITU-D (NOW4ITU-D), an initiative which is designed to encourage gender balance in the activities of the ITU Development Sector. In 2022, she successfully chaired Committee 3 on Objectives of the World Telecommunications Development Conference held in Kigali, Rwanda.

Ms. Flutur has served as focal point and main coordinator for the preparations and organization of the 2022 ITU Plenipotentiary Conference in Bucharest, Romania.
